Notice of Cancer Screening [がん健診を受け忘れていませんか]

Notification of various medical checkups including examination labels was posted to those who are 40 years old or older in mid-May of this year. Please check the details of the medical checkups and how to take them, then receive the medical checkups. If you have moved to Oizumi-machi after April 2024, or if you have not received the notification and would like to have a cancer screening, please contact the Health Promotion Division (Kenko Zukuri-ka).

How to Apply:

Common Information for Each Cancer Screening

Please apply to the Health Promotion Division (Kenko Zukuri-ka) directly by phone, or via the LINE account of Oizumi-machi. ※Indivisual Gastric Cancer Screening shall be applied directly at the Health Promotion Division (Kenko Zukuri-ka). Notes:

- Eligible age is as of March 31st, 2025.
- Households on welfare and households exempt from municipal resident taxes can be exempted from paying the co-payment by submitting an application to the Health Promotion Division (Kenko Zukuri-ka) at least one day before the cancer screening.
- Each cancer screening is available once per fiscal year.
- Those who have not registered in Oizumi-machi as of the cancer screening day, the examinations are not available.

[Gastric Cancer Screening]

(1) Gastro X-Ray Examination (Group Cancer Screening)

- · Eligiblity: Those who are 40 years old or older
- Co-Payment: ¥500
- 2 Endoscopic Examination (Indivisual Cancer Screening)

*Not applicable to those who underwent the town's endoscopy in FY2023.

If you receive a cancer screening without applying to the town, you will be required to pay the full amount.

- Eligibility: Those who are 40 years old or older
- Available period: Until January 31st (Fri.), 2025
- Medical facility: Medical institutions in Tatebayashi-shi/Ora-gun
- Co-Payment: ¥2000 (Pay to the medical institution directly.)

[Colorectal Cancer Screening]

- Eligibility: Those who are 40 years old or older
- Co-Payment: ¥500

[Breast Cancer Screening]

- Eligibility: Women who are 40 years old or older
- Co-Payment: ¥1,000



Integration of My Number Card and Health Insurance Card [マイナンバーカードと健康保険証の一体化]

Due to the promulgation of the Cabinet Order that stipulates the date of abolition of the current health insurance card, the current health insurance card will not be issued, including reissuance, after December 2, 2024 (Monday). After the abolition of the health insurance card, please use the "My Number Card integrated with the health insurance card (Maina Hoken-sho)" registered for use as a health insurance card.

However, a valid health insurance card that has already been issued as of the date of abolition may be used until the expiration date indicated on the card if there is no change in the information on the face of the card.

<< If you do not have "My Number Card integrated with the health insurance card (Maina Hoken-sho)" >> After December 2, for those who do not have "My Number Card integrated with the health insurance card (Maina Hoken-sho)", "Qualification Certificate (Shikaku Kakunin-sho)" will be issued before the expiration date of the currently issued health insurance card. By presenting the Qualification Certificate (Shikaku Kakunin-sho) to a medical institution, etc., you can receive health care treatment in the same way as with your existing health insurance card.

Note:

Even after the abolition of the health insurance card, procedures related to the acquisition and loss of health insurance eligibility will continue to be required regardless of whether the card is used or not. Orange Ribbon Campaign for the Prevention of Child Abuse [秋のこどもまんなか月間]

November is the "Orange Ribbon Campaign for the Prevention of Child Abuse". The Orange Ribbon carries the message "Prevention of Child Abuse". Child abuse is a problem that should be addressed and resolved by society as a whole.

Types of Child Abuse:

Even if it is intended as "discipline", yelling, hitting, or any other verbal or violent behavior are abusive. There are physical abuse (such as hitting or kicking), sexual abuse (such as sexual acts on the child), neglect (such as locking the child in the house) and psychological abuse (such as verbal threats and other forms).

- Preventing Child Abuse:
 - Early detection and response are impotant to prevent abuse.

Do not hesitate to contact us if you have a child around you who you believe has been abused (contact can be made anonymously). In addition, since problems with child rearing can lead to abuse, one way to prevent abuse is to seek advice when you have problems with child rearing or childbirth.

National Fire Prevention Campaign in Autumn [秋の全国火災予防運動]

"National Fire Prevention Campaign in Autumn" is being held from November 9th (Sat.) until November 15th (Fri.). It is the time of year when fires are most likely to occur. Let's protect our lives and property by preventing fires from occurring.

<< Four Habits to Protect Your Own Life >>

- 1. Never smoking in bed. Never allow smoking in bed.
- 2. Do not place flammable objects around heaters.
- 3. When using a stove, stay close to the stove.
- 4. Remove dust from electrical outlets and unplug unnecessary plugs.

<< Six Measures to Protect Your Own Life >>

- 1. To prevent fires, use stoves and other appliances with safety devices.
- 2. In order to detect fires early, residential fire alarms should be inspected regularly and replaced in 10 years approximately.
- 3. To prevent the spread of fire, keep rooms tidy and use flammable bedding, clothing, and curtains.
- 4. Install fire extinguishers or other equipment, and make sure you know how to use them.
- 5. Always be prepared with evacuation routes and evacuation method.
- 6. Conduct community-wide fire prevention measures by participating in fire and disaster prevention drills and visiting individual residents.

<< Installation and Maintenance of Residential Fire alarms >>

All homes are required to have residential fire alarms. Be sure to install one to protect yourself and your family. If you have already installed one, be sure to check its operation regularly.
