Trash Collection/Self Carry-in during the Year-End and New Year Holidays

Household trash will be collected as described in the trash collection calendar during the year-end and new year holidays. Please understand that collection time may be delayed due to congestion of the trash disposal facilities. In addition, please DO NOT put trash out after collection or on non-collection days.

■ The days not to collect burnable trash:

The area where burnable trash is usually collected on Monday and Thursday > NOT TO COLLECT on January 2nd (Thu.), 2025 The area where burnable trash is usually collected on Tuesday and Friday > NOT TO COLLECT on January 3rd (Fri.), 2025

- The period not to collect non-burnable & recyclable trash ⇒ December 30th (Mon.), 2024 January 3rd (Fri.),2025
- << Disposal Facilities for Pruned branches>> Pruned branches are not accepted while the recycling contractor is closed.

<< Year-End Special Operation of the Trash Disposal Facilities>>

The Trash Disposal Facilities will accept self-carrying of household trash during the year-end. Since the year-end period is very crowded every year, so please bring your household trash on any household trash acceptance day other than the year-end to avoid congestion. In addition, please note that Oizumi-machi Hoka Ni-cho Seiso Center only accepts over-sized household trash (60cm or longer size) such as sofas, mattresses, chests of drawers, or etc.



<For Single-Mother/Single-Father Families> Provision of School Entrance Preparation Allowance

[<母子・父子家庭>入学·進学支度金を支給]

The town will provide school entrance preparation allowance for children of single-mother families and single-father families to prepare for entering elementary or junior high school in fiscal year 2025. For families with a student who plans to enter a senior high school, the application will be accepted in April 2025.

■ Eligibility:

Those who have become single-mother or single-father families due to be reavement, divorce or etc., and those who are rearing children without parents, and also who meet all of the following conditions are eligible.

- Those who live in Oizumi Town
- Those who support a child and live with the child
- Those who have not been taxed on their income for 2023
- Those who are not receiving public assistance
- How to Apply:

Fill out the necessary information in the application form, and apply it with required documents directly to the Child Rearing Support Section (Kosodate Shien Gakari) of the Children Affairs Division (Kodomo-ka) at the 24th counter on the 3rd floor.

- Payment Amount:
 - For elementary school: ¥10,000
 - For junior high school: ¥15,000
- Application Period:

January 14th (Tue.), 2025 - February 28th (Fri.), 2025 except Saturdays and Sundays.

*The application for students entering high school is scheduled to be accepted after April 2025. Please note that the above period is not applicable.

Provision of Fund for School Enrollment Readiness [新入学準備費を支給]

The town will provide readiness fund for families whose children have difficulties in attending school for financial reasons.

- Eligibility: Those who meet all of the following conditions are eligible.
 - Living in the town as of February 1st, 2025
 - Scheduled to enter elementaray school or junior high school in April, 2025
 - Meeting the criteria for "Jun-You- Hogo" under "the Reiwa 6 Nendo Shugaku Enjo Seido (Financial Aid for Educational Expenses system in FY2024)"
- How to Apply:

Fill out the necessary information in the application form, and apply it with required documents directly to one of the following applicable schools.

- For elementary school: Apply to the elementary school that your child plans to enter.
- For junior high school: Apply to the elementary school that your child attends currently.
- Application Period: January 6th (Mon.), 2025 January 24th (Fri.), 2025 except Saturdays, Sundays and National holidays.
- Payment Date: Scheduled on February 14th (Fri.), 2025
- Payment Amount:
 - For elementary school: ¥57,060
 - For junior high school: ¥63,000

* An application form is available at the Educational Administration Division (Kyoiku-Kanri-ka) at the 22nd counter on the 3rd floor, elementary and junior high schools in the town. In addition, you can down-load it from the Oizumi-machi website. Incidentally, the town also aids a part of other expenses for school such as school supplies, school lunch, or etc.

Deduction of National Pension Insurance Premiums as Social Insurance Premiums

[国民年金保険料は社会保険料として控除]

National Pension Insurance premiums are deducted from income for the year as a deduction for social insurance premium under the Income Tax Law and Local Tax Law, thereby reducing the amount of tax. The deduction is based on the total amount of insurance premiums paid from January to December in 2024. If you have paid insurance premiums for the past fiscal year or additional premiums, or if you have paid national pension insurance premiums owed by family members, the deduction is also available for those premiums. In order to receive the reduction, the certificates needs to be attached to the declaration form when making year-end adjustments (Nenmatsu-chosei) or filing tax returns (Kakutei Shinkoku).

■ Required Certificates

A document proving that you have paid the Premiums such as "Certificate of Deduction for Social Insurance Premiums (Shakai Hoken-ryo (Kokumin Nenkin Hoken-ryo) Koujo Shomei-sho)"

- For those who paid National Pension Insurance Premiums between January 1st, 2024 and September 30th, 2024;
 - ⇒ The Certificate has been mailed in November, 2024 from the Japan Pension Service.
- For those who paid National Pension Insurance Premiums this year for the first time between October 1st and December 31st;
 - ⇒ The Certificate will be mailed in early February, 2025 from the Japan Pension Service.
