Concerning Cervical Cancer [ご存じですか?子宮頸がん]

■ Overview of Cervical cancer

Cervical cancer is a cancer of the cervix, the area near the exit of the uterus. In Japan, about 10,000 people are diagnosed with this disease each year. The number of patients begins to increase in their 30s, and the disease affects most people in their 40s. Cervical cancer is known to be caused by infection with the human papillomavirus (HPV).

HPV is said to infect most women at least once in their lifetime, but infection does not immediately lead to cancer. Preventing HPV infection helps prevent cancer.

■ Cervical cancer vaccine ※ Please note that the vaccination is not mandatory.

In Japan, women between the ages of 12 and 16 years old can receive the vaccination free of charge. The town will mail the information notifice and a vaccine screening questionnaire to first-year junior high school students in April.

■ Catch-up vaccination

Catch-up vaccinations are offered to women born on or after April 2, 1997, who have missed the opportunity to receive the regular vaccination. Catch-up vaccination will be available free of charge in FY2025.

Those who wish to receive the catch-up vaccination must have received the first vaccination by March 31, 2025.

■ Recommendation for cervical cancer screening

Cervical cancer is a cervical disease that can be cured in many cases without loss of life if detected early and treated appropriately. It is recommended to have a checkup once every two years, so be proactive about it.

The town offers two types of checkups as group checkups and individual checkups conducted at medical institutions.

For those who will report Births, Deaths, Stillbirths, Marriages, and Divorces in 2025 [令和7年度に出生・死亡・死産・婚姻・離婚の届出をする人へ]

When a birth, death, stillbirth, marriage, or divorce occurs, a "birth notification", "death notification", "stillbirth notification", "marriage notification", and "divorce notification" must be submitted to the municipal office.

Every five years, in the year when the National Census is conducted, we also request the entry of occupation (and the entry of industry on the death certificate) in accordance with the "Current Population Survey (Occupation/Industry)".

Notification of births, deaths, stillbirths, marriages, and divorces are investigated as the "Current Population Survey" conducted by the Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare. The results are used as important basic data for public health, occupational health, social welfare, and other policies.

Please be assured that the information used in the demographic survey is strictly protected by statistical laws.

- Eligibility: Births, deaths, stillbirths, marriages, and divorces from April 1, 2025 to March 31, 2026
- Survey method: Fill in each occupation when reporting each form
- Example entry:
- Doctors, teachers, etc. → Professional and technical positions
- General clerks, etc. → Office workers
- Sales person, sales employee, etc. → Sales work
- Hairdressers, home helpers, etc. → Service industry

 - Wearing helmets and obeying traffic rules when using bicycles and/or specified small motorized bicycles, etc.






